3. Purpose and legal basis of data processing

The legal basis for the processing of this data is Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. b GDPR.

4. Recipients of the data or categories of recipients

As part of the application procedure and the administration of workstations, individual staff members of the administrative division, the media and public relations division, the library and the academic staff will have access to the data. The MEDLINQ Software System GMBH will receive system access for the limited purpose of software maintenance and the provision of support services. Data is not transmitted to other third parties.

5. Storage duration

In the event you are granted a research stay at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative and International Private Law, your data will be stored for a period of 3 years following the conclusion of your research stay.

6. Your rights

You have in principle the right to information (Article 15 GDPR), correction (Article 16 GDPR), deletion (Article 17 (1) GDPR), restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR), data trans-mission (Article 20 GDPR), and revocation of consent (Article 7 (3) GDPR).
